We seek a respectful and peaceful togetherness, characterized by empathy and tolerance. Everyone is WELCOME!

To ensure harmony, we have established a few rules which are to be followed.

§1 SOCIAL INTERACTION

To carry any kinds of weapons is forbidden.


In- and outdoors have to be kept orderly and clean. Visitors and users have to pay attention to noise regulation, especially after 11 pm, and have to avoid disrupting the residents. Special arrangements (e.g. boule track) are to be followed. The usage of the outdoor grounds beyond our opening hours is at your own risk.

Dogs are not allowed in the Steinhaus and have to be on a leash on the grounds. Dog owners are responsible for their dogs and can be made liable in case of damage.

The inventory has to be treated with care. Damages have to be reported immediately. If damages were made on purpose you will be held responsible for the damages. The usage of items of furniture and articles of purely practical value like billards, table tennis and football table is to be made in agreement with the associates of the Steinhaus.

We assume no liability for your own property (e.g. bags, bicycle and so on).

§2 YOUTH PROTECTION

The terms of the youth protection act (JuSchG) and narcotics act (BtMG) apply.

Children and Teenagers under the age of 16 have to leave the Steinhaus and the grounds after 10 pm at the latest. Special regulations apply only at specific events for this age group if a socio-pedagogical care is guaranteed. Youth under the age of 18 have to leave the Steinhaus and the grounds at 12 am at the latest.

SMOKING

Smoking is allowed at the age of 18. The Steinhaus is liable to the non-smoking protection; every room is equipped with a fire alarm system. Therefore smoking is forbidden in all rooms. Adults are asked to be considerate of children and adolescents.

ALCOHOL

Bringing along alcoholic beverages is forbidden. Youth under the age of 16 are not allowed to buy and consume alcohol in the STEINHAUS and on the enclosed grounds.

DRUGS

The consumption of drugs, the possession and the passing on of illegal drugs is strictly forbidden.

Violation of the narcotics act (BtMG) will be reported to the police.

§3 CONSEQUENCES

The instructions of the associates of the STEINHAUS e.V. and the instructed people (e.g. Security) are to be followed.

The STEINHAUS e.V. reserves for itself, to make use of their householder's rights. People who are members of extremist parties or organisations, are assigned to the extremist scene, have made a misanthropic, have glorified violence, are racist, nationalist or anti-Semitic are not allowed to enter an event nor will they gain access to the Steinhaus grounds.

By violation against the householder's rights or instructions of the associates those responsible hold the right to ban you from the house.
